Following are the candidates' brief biographies:

This role includes managing the endowment of the university. He continues to serve as the treasurer of Standifer Gap SDA Church and has been a member of the Memorial Hospital Quality and Finance committee for nearly 15 years.
- **Olson Perry** is a faculty member in the communication department at Oakwood University. He is also a contract copywriter and interpersonal communication speaker specializing in relationship communication. Previously, he was the Southern Union Director of Communication, *Southern Tidings* Editor, General Manager of WSMC-FM, and a member of the communication faculty at Southern Adventist University. He is currently secretary of the Collegedale Credit Union Board and serves on the personnel committee. He has been a member of the credit union since 1977.
